

Team Coach

The Team Coach is responsible for coaching and mentoring the players to ensure that they understand the rules of the game format and the competition they are playing in.

Responsible to: Club Committee

DESIRED SKILLS

- Understanding of competition match rules or willing to become familiar with them
- Able to make on-field decisions
- Good knowledge of the game formats and common rules
- Able to work under pressure
- Good communicator
- Ability to deal with a wide range of players, officials and supporters.

KEY ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Adhere to the mission, vision, and values of the Club
- Facilitate coaching and practice sessions at a club nominated time and venue.
- Ensure regular timely communication with the team members and parents to organise team activities.
- Attend club and association organised meetings to learn and develop coaching strategies for the players.
- Delegate couching duties if you are unavailable to facilitate the practice and/or game sessions.
- Administer team selection on PlayHQ prior to each game and amend the scores as needed.
- Ensure to arrive at least 30 minutes before the scheduled games start at the ground to setup and be ready especially for the home games and ensure games run on time.
- Ensure insurance checklist is completed before each game to ensure that ground conditions are safe for the players.
- Home games must be scored by a team parent so ensure a volunteer is ready before the game.
- Ensure results and statistics are entered in PlayHQ within 5 days after each game conclusion.
- Communicate with the club committee and/or fellow coaches to source players at least 5 days before the game if you are short of players.
- Encourage healthy and cooperative learning environment for the players. Adhere to the club and association's guidelines to promote positive and welcoming environment for all the players on the field during practice as well as games.
- Respond to the club committee's request for information in a timely manner.
- Discuss rules around potential issues such as giving LBW for plumb instances to ensure that both the teams are adhering to mutually agreed consistent and fair rules.
- Ensure that the match ball used in the game is provided by the club and approved for use in the given match situation.
- Ensure all match officials are available
- Provide umpiring duties and coordinate with other parents to ensure adequate coverage.
- Coordinate transport of players so they are ready to play before the scheduled start of the game (if required)
- Escalate any incidents or concerns to the club secretary for review and investigation.
- Ensure that the competition rules are followed and report any breaches to the club secretary for escalation and resolution.
